## INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS | Zagreb



The four-year undergraduate International Business program provides students with knowledge and understanding of business practices and international strategic management with a focus on marketing and finance. Through theory and more importantly – practice, students are being prepared for business in a dynamic global environment. They learn how to take local business global. Along with the core business classes, students also take related classes oriented toward the global environment, including Global Business Environment, Global Marketing, Global Entry and Competition Strategies, and Finance in Global Environment.

In addition to business management skills (strategic planning, team leadership, time management, organization), students develop their communication and presentation skills, gain confidence in public speaking, and learn how to communicate fluently in business English.

USA-Croatia Global Exchange gives students in the International Business program an opportunity to partake in a unique cultural exchange program, joining a cohort of students from RIT's campuses in Rochester and Croatia. Students start the semester in Croatia for a span of six weeks after which they travel to Rochester to complete the rest of the program courses.

# HOSPITALITY AND TOURISM MANAGEMENT Dubrovnik

The four-year undergraduate Hospitality and Tourism Management program is multidisciplinary and prepares students for professional and managerial positions in careers in tourism, one of the biggest and fastest-growing industries in the world.

Students take courses that build a strong concept of the industry as a whole by studying accounting, marketing, finance, economics, business management, behavioral sciences, human resource management, service management, nutrition, food preparation, food and beverage service principles, hotel operations, travel, tourism, and other topics.

During their studies, students can participate in various projects and work with the industry partners. *Puttin' on the RITz* is one such project. It is RIT's gala dinner fully prepared and organized by RIT students. Mentored by the industry experts and their professors, students of Dubrovnik and Rochester campuses organized this event in Dubrovnik in 2017. This enables students to put all their knowledge to practice.

## WEB AND MOBILE COMPUTING | Dubrovnik & Zagreb

The four-year Web and Mobile Computing / Information Technology undergraduate program prepares students for perspective and sought-after professions in the areas of programming and web and mobile application design. The program explores full stack application development while paying attention to the visual design and understanding user expectations. The students learn how to build and work with all the different layers of application development which makes them incredibly valuable to employers seeking today's application developers. They learn how to integrate the server-side code with the client-side UI to provide responsive applications, applications optimized for mobile and desktop performance.

Fourth-year students work on their Senior Project together with their colleagues from RIT campuses in the U.S. and Dubai. Students learn about the importance of teamwork, and experience how to work with someone overseas which is a common practice in companies operating on a global market. Most importantly, students work on real life cases which end up being implemented.
